ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
2017-06

WHEREAS, Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2005-32 provides the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of each county shall exercise administrative supervision over all the Courts in their county; and,

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 2016-02 was adopted to meet the requirements for the process for selection of Special Judicial Officers and in conformance with the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration §1-305 and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2004-101; and,

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 2016-02 provides in part the process for selection of Special Judicial Officers for the Limited Jurisdiction Courts which includes Municipal Courts; and,

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 2016-02 provides that application forms are to be obtained from the Mohave County Human Resource Office or designee, and that said applications are to be filed with the Mohave County Human Resource Office; and,


WHEREAS, the Mohave County Human Resource Office is not involved with respect to any applications for the selection of Special Judicial Officers for Municipal Courts; and,

WHEREAS, a need has arisen to clarify and amend Administrative Order 2016-02 to reflect its application to the Municipal Courts and to amend the same to add the applicable municipality's Human Resource Department is to be utilized for the application procedure.

IT IS ORDERED that Administrative Order 2016-02 is hereby clarified to apply to Special Judicial Officer positions arising in the municipalities of this county's court system unless the municipality has adopted appropriate policies and procedures within its municipal charter or by ordinance for the selection of such Special Judicial Officers.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any application process for the appointment of any Special Municipal Court Judicial Officer shall utilize the services of that respective municipality's Human Resource Department or designee.
