

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO
 SEEK THE DEATH PENALTY**

14 The State of Arizona, by the Mohave County Attorney, and through the
 15 undersigned Deputy County Attorney, pursuant to Rule 15.1(g)(1) of the Arizona Rules of
 16 Criminal Procedure, hereby gives notice that the State intends to seek the death penalty
 17 in this case.

18 The State alleges the following aggravating factors pursuant to A.R.S. §13-751(F)
 19 exist in this case:

- 20 • A.R.S. § 13-703(F)(2): The defendant has been convicted of a serious
 21 offense, whether preparatory or completed.
 - 22 a. Defendant is charged in the instant case with serious offenses:
 Count 2 – Kidnapping.
- 23 • A.R.S. § 13-703(F)(6): The defendant committed the offense in an
 24 especially heinous, cruel or depraved manner.
 - 25 a. Cruelty - the physical & mental suffering of the victim, I.G.-C.

b. Heinous and depraved - the mental state and attitude of the defendant, as reflected in his words and actions.

- A.R.S. § 13-703(F)(9): The defendant was an adult at the time the offense was committed and the murdered person was under fifteen years of age.
- A.R.S. § 13-703(F)(13): The offense was committed in a cold, calculated manner without pretense of moral or legal justification.


