ORDER DECLINING SPECIAL ACTION JURISDICTION

The court, Presiding Judge Jennifer B. Campbell and Judges Paul J. McMurdie and Kent E. Cattani participating, has reviewed the petition for special action. Ariz. R. Crim. P. 6.7(b) requires a defendant to show a need for confidentiality to support an ex parte request for appointment of a defense investigator, expert witness, or mitigation specialist. As the record reflects no such showing, and without prejudice to future ex parte requests under Rule 6.7,

IT IS ORDERED the Court of Appeals declines special action jurisdiction.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED vacating this court's previous order requiring the filing and service of a response.
