
As a threshold matter, the State lacks standing to either object to the defense's ability to gain funding or to object to the procedural mechanism by which the defense is authorized to obtain funding.



1 The Defendant does not lose his right to funding for counsel, experts, or
2 investigation for either guilt or mitigation because the case is no longer capital.
3
4 The reasons for filing ex parte and under seal have not changed. To obtain
5 funding, the defense must explain what they are seeking funding for and why.
6
7 This requires identifying experts, what is being investigated, and which
8 documents are needed. Those items constitute work product in its purest form
9 under Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure 15.4(b)(1) and is protected from
10 disclosure.
11

12 Making funding requests public tilts the playing field in favor of the State.
13
14 The State would have a roadmap of the defense's plan, but the defense does not
15 similarly have a roadmap of the State's plan, because the State is fully funded and
16 does not need to seek court authorization for funds. Allowing the State to see the
17 defense's strategy or to object to funding denies the defendant's rights under the
18 5th, 6th, 8th, and 14th Amendments to the U.S. Constitution and corresponding
19 provision of the Arizona Constitution.

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
