**Application to Set Aside Conviction (For Criminal Convictions Only)**

In accordance with Arizona Revised Statute (A.R.S.) §13-905, this application may be submitted to the Court for review of a criminal conviction. The application may be submitted once the person convicted of the criminal offense has fulfilled the conditions of probation or sentence and discharge by the Court. If the Judge grants the application, the judgment of guilt is set aside and reported to the Motor Vehicle Division and/or the Department of Public Safety in accordance with the statute.

**Criminal convictions that are not eligible:**

Not all criminal offenses are eligible to be set aside. Examples include: dangerous offenses, offenses which the person is required or ordered by the Courts to register pursuant to section 13-3811, offenses which have a finding of sexual motivation pursuant to section 13-118, an offense in which the victim is a minor under fifteen years of age, or an offense in violation of section 28-3473, any local ordinance relating to stopping, standing or operation of a vehicle or title 28, chapter 3, except a violation of section 28-693 or any local ordinance relating to the same subject matter as section 28-693. For a complete review of non-eligible charges please review A.R.S. §13-905K.

**Instructions for Filing**

Complete all necessary information on the form and file the form with the Court.

It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure the Prosecutor's office receives a copy of the filing. After the opposing party has had an opportunity to review your motion and respond, the Judge will review and rule within 1-2 weeks.
