**Arizona Court of Appeals to hold Oral Arguments in Kingman at**  
**Lee Williams High School**

The Arizona Court of Appeals Division I will hold oral arguments in Kingman on Thursday, February 7<sup>th</sup> at 10:00am. Twice a year, the Arizona Court of Appeals holds oral argument at a local high school before a student audience. For their spring 2019 program, Lee Williams High School in Kingman has been selected as the site for oral argument in a pending civil case.

Following the oral arguments, the Court of Appeals will participate in answering questions about the court system, the judicial branch, and careers in law. Additionally, local Judges from both the Superior Court and the Justice Court will be in attendance. While this event is primarily for students others in the community that would like to attend are welcome and should arrive at the school no later than 9:40 AM to allow sufficient time for security screening and to be seated. Court begins promptly at 10:00. Presiding Judge Charles W. Gurtler Jr. noted that this will be a wonderful opportunity for High School students to participate in the judicial process and interact with the Judges of the Court of Appeals.
