Discussion ensues regarding scheduling.

Mr. Coughlin requests the Oral Motion to Dismiss be submitted in writing; Mr. Oehler objects and presents arguments; discussion ensues.

IT IS ORDERED setting **Oral Arguments on Mr. Oehler’s Oral Motion to Dismiss on Friday, September 16, 2022 at 9:30 a.m.**; this hearing will be in conjunction with the request for Status Hearing based on attachments to the Request for Status Hearing filed on June 15, 2022.

The Court notes that Counsel will also argue the appropriateness of the notice that was filed by Counsel for the Petitioner on Friday, July 27, 2022.

The Court provides Mr. Coughlin with the e-mail of its Judicial Assistant so that he can submit the Notice to the Court.

Parties are authorized to appear via zoom and the court notes its preference that Parties appear by zoom video.

Mr. Oehler requests that Mr. Coughlin provide his filings for the hearing at a reasonable time.

The Court directs Mr. Coughlin to submit his objection to the Oral Motion to Dismiss no later than Tuesday, August 30, 2022.

The Court directs Mr. Oehler to file his objections to the Notice received by Mr. Coughlin no later than August 20, 2022.

The Court recesses at 9:13 a.m.
