MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

- 1. When Hon. Judge Jantzen signed the February 2022 Order for Plaintiff to serve Rule 19 Parties, Plaintiff's attorney Coughlin filed an Appeal that was denied due to the Court including Rule 54 (b) in the Order when no parties or claims were dismissed with the Order.
- 2. Plaintiff's attorney began working with Defense Counsel Oehler for an agreement on the language for the Proposed Order on the instructions for the Plaintiff to follow in mailing the Service Packet of documents.
- 3. Plaintiff's attorney Coughlin withdrew during a Status Conference on October 26, 2022 and the Court advised that any objections to Proposed Orders shall be filed within 20 days.
- 4. On November 14, 2022 Plaintiff timely filed her Notice of Proposed Final Orders and the Proposed Final Orders that was comprised of Plaintiff's October 28, 2022 Proposed Order and Defense Counsel Oehler's Proposed Final Form Order. Plaintiff included a Proposed Summons and Proposed Waiver of Service Form designed for service on Indispensable Parties that was intended to be clear that the necessary and indispensable parties were being joined in the matter because the outcome of the case could affect their rights but they were not being sued.
- 5. The Court reviewed the Proposed Orders and was to send out a response on February 17, 2023 pursuant to a Status Conference on that day.
- 6. Judge Jantzen recused himself and this case was reassigned to the Hon Judge Nielson of Navajo County as a visiting judge to Mohave County on May 4, 2023.
  - 7. Judge Nielson held a Status Conference on or about June 8, 2023.
