ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
2004-20


I have reviewed and considered an application from Dr. Charles A. Wilson, D.O., for a two year deferral from jury service. The jury commissioner has already granted a postponement of the original summons issued for a particular trial in May, 2004.

The nature of the request is the undue hardship on those patients who would not be able to obtain medical treatment on their appointment dates if Dr. Wilson serves on jury duty, and he indicates an average of 30 appointments per day. Random selection of prospective jurors, required by law, does not permit the court to target Dr. Wilson for service on a case known to require only a one or two day commitment.

Therefore, for these reasons, and in accordance with our policy for jury service,

IT IS ORDERED excusing Dr. Charles A. Wilson from jury service for a period of two (2) years ending April 30, 2006.
