ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

2008-04

There is a need to appoint qualified persons to serve during absences by judges in Mohave County Superior Court. Justices of the Peace John S. Taylor and Jill Davis are full-time justices of the peace, otherwise qualified to serve as superior court judges pro tempore, and willing to assist the superior court by hearing cases on an occasional basis. In addition, during the annual judicial conference, and possibly during local continuing education programs, there may be occasions on which no superior court judges are available for emergency matters. On the authority of the Chief Justice of the Arizona Supreme Court, by his administrative order No. 2003-20,

IT IS ORDERED that the following persons named below are appointed as judges pro tempore of the Superior Court in Mohave County for a term beginning on July 1, 2008 and ending June 30, 2009:

Jill Wachtel-Davis Arizona State Bar #016898

FURTHER ORDERED that John S. Taylor and Jill Wachtel-Davis shall serve without compensation above their established salaries as justices of the peace.
