ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
2015-21

WHEREAS Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2005-32 provides that the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in each county shall exercise administrative supervision over all the courts in their county; and


WHEREAS A.R.S. § 12-213 authorizes the office of commissioner with an annual salary set by the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court which may not exceed ninety per cent of the salary of a judge of the Superior Court;

WHEREAS Court Commissioners currently accrue paid time off and according to adopted procedures they would be eligible for a payout of paid time off at the time of separation which may result in them exceeding the salary cap established in A.R.S. § 12-213.

IT IS ORDERED that Court Commissioners shall no longer be eligible to accrue paid time off effective June 27, 2015. They will be treated like Superior Court Judges for time off. Their time off will now be at the discretion of the Presiding Judge. Additionally, there will be no set number of days of time off, no rollover of days, and no payout when a Court Commissioner leaves court service.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the current Court Commissioners shall use all paid time off within the next month or be paid out for their existing time.
