


WHEREAS, the Mohave County Clerk of Court currently completes their minute entries in 12-point font and the court forms they provide as well as the forms provided by the law library to the public and litigants are in 12-point font and;

WHEREAS, if the Clerk of Court were to comply with the Rules of Civil Procedure 5.2(b)(1) and Rule 5.2(b)(1)(D) and increase the font size and margins of minute entries and forms, the resulting change would have a significant cost to the Court, to the public and would hinder access to the court. Additionally, the increased volume of paper would also negatively impact the records department, scanning process and caseflow goals of the court.

THEREFORE, to avoid additional costs, ensure ongoing efficiency in operations and to maintain access to the courts, and in the interest of judicial resources;

IT IS ORDERED, that the Clerk of Superior Court minute entries and the forms provided by the Clerk or the law library to the public will be exempt from complying with Arizona Rule of Civil Procedure 5.2(b)(1) and 5.2(b)(1)(D).
