ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO. 16

WHEREAS, Mohave County Superior Court is committed to combating COVID-19, protecting the health and safety of community members, court staff, county employees, attorneys, and contractors; and

WHEREAS, Mohave County Superior Court acknowledges that hospitals and care facilities are prohibiting public access to those facilities in an effort to minimize the spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, Mohave County Superior Court is committed to protecting the rights of proposed wards and/or protected persons who are patients in medical or psychiatric facilities in Title 14 Guardianship/Conservatorship matters while balancing the need to follow national, state, and local guidance and orders limiting public contact and encouraging social distancing; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the Arizona Supreme Court encouraged the elimination of in-
2 person contact to the extent possible in Administrative Order 2020-48; and


3 **WHEREAS**, the Arizona Supreme Court authorized the Presiding Superior
4 Court Judge to adopt local rules and orders to address the current public health
5 emergency to enable necessary court operations in Administrative Order 2020-
6 48;

7 **IT IS ORDERED** that statutorily mandated investigations in Title 14
8 Guardianship/Conservatorship proceedings where the patient is in a medical or
9 psychiatric care facility be conducted on a modified basis, utilizing collateral
10 sources of information to the extent possible by reviewing relevant records and
11 conducting secondary source interviews;

12 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Public Fiduciary and/or Court
13 appointed investigator conduct electronic or telephonic interviews with the patient
14 in a medical or psychiatric care facility to the extent practicable in order to avoid
15 in-person contact;

16 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that all reports to the Court specify the
17 manner in which the investigation was conducted and all collateral sources of
18 information utilized by the reporter.
