ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
2026 - 21

WHEREAS, Rule 72 of the Rules of Civil Procedure provides Rules for the Fast Trial and Alternative Resolution (FASTAR) Program, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Rules of Civil Procedure Rule 72(a)(3), effective July 1, 2025, a decision to require arbitration of certain claims or to establish a FASTAR program must be incorporated into a superior court order that is filed with the Clerk of Superior Court, Mohave County, and

WHEREAS, on August 12, 2025, the Judges of the Superior Court in Mohave County unanimously voted to establish a FASTAR program as required in Rule 72(a)(2) of the Rules of Civil Procedure,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, effective June 1, 2026, that Mohave County Superior Court establishes a FASTAR program, and Rules 101 through 126 of the Rules for the FASTAR Program, instead of Rules 72 through 77 of the Rules of Civil Procedure, apply to civil cases within the limits set forth in the FASTAR Program. The Rules for the FASTAR Program will govern all proceedings in an action commenced after their effective date.
