Judges and judicial employees have a legal obligation under A.R.S. §38-501 et. seq., the Arizona Code of Judicial of Judicial Conduct, and the Arizona Code of Conduct for Judicial Employees, to diligently identify, disclose and avoid conflicts of interest. Additionally, judges and judicial employees are required to disclose any actual or potential business-related conflicts of interest by completing the form below and submitting it to the Superior Court Human Resource Office for review and forwarding to the Mohave County Clerk of the Board.

* A.R.S. 38-502 "Definition"
"Relative" means the spouse, child, child's child, parent, grandparent, brother or sister of the whole or half blood and their spouses and the parent, brother, sister or child of a spouse."

* A.R.S. 38-503. Conflict of interest; exemptions; employment prohibition
A. Any public officer or employee of a public agency who has, or whose relative has, a substantial interest in any contract, sale, purchase or service to such public agency shall make known that interest in the official records of such public agency and shall refrain from voting upon or otherwise participating in any manner as an officer or employee in such contract, sale or purchase.

B. Any public officer or employee who has, or whose relative has, a substantial interest in any decision of a public agency shall make known such interest in the official records of such public agency and shall refrain from participating in any manner as an officer or employee in such decision.
