RIGHTS

When juveniles are detained in the juvenile detention center, they have certain rights. These rights are as follows:

- Receiving proper shelter, food and clothing
- Practicing recognized religions and receiving directions from a religious leader
- Receiving proper medical care
- Talking with their attorney
- Receiving exercise and recreation
- Having a visit from a parent or guardian
- Making one phone call a week to parent or guardian after school hours or on weekends during non-programming times
- Sending and receiving letters approved by Probation Officers which may be sent to parents and legal guardians.
- Filing a grievance if they believe they are not being treated fairly.
